What is IPrep?

IPrep is a mock interview program for students in the school and TAFE sectors. It provides students from year 9 to 12 with a one to one interview experience to help them prepare for job and course interviews in the near future.



HOW IT WORKS



It is coordinated and managed by Stride staff. The interviewers are volunteers who may be retired, semi-retired, working, studying or any variation of these. Our volunteers are people who are interested in supporting young people and have some experience in industry.

- The school identifies the year level or group for the interviews.
- Stride works with the school to schedule the interviews and arranges volunteers to be present on the day, or under COVID restrictions, these interviews are conducted online.
- Students attend prepared as if they were attending a real interview.
- Stride provides all the support material required including: evaluation forms, suggested interview questions and a schedule. Prior to the event volunteers receive specific information about the school and the cohort of students we will be interviewing.
- Each student has a 10 or 15 minute interview with a volunteer.
- After each interview the volunteers has 5 minutes to fill out a brief evaluation form that will be forwarded to the teacher at the end of the session. The teacher then gives them to the students.
- An IPrep event may be as brief as 2 hours for a small group of students or an all-day event for a whole year level. There is always a team of interviewers involved, with onsite support from Stride staff.

Due to availability of volunteers, IPrep is currently only offered in the Melbourne Metropolitan area.

THE VOLUNTEERS



All our volunteers must have a current Working With Children Check and Police Check. Our interviewers are supported with an induction and all training materials are provided. As part of the interview interviewers may also review and give feedback on the student's resume and cover letter.

Volunteers are sent an email outlining upcoming IPrep events including the school, location, date and time and are invited to respond to those they can commit to.
